MOUND CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON AN INTERIM ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM WITHIN THE CITY ON LAND USE AND SUBDIVISION APPLICATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF MULTI-FAMILY HOUSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Mound, as part of its regular meeting scheduled for Tuesday, March 14, 2023 at 7:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers in the Centennial Building, 5341 Maywood Road, will hold a public hearing to consider and take action on an interim ordinance establishing a moratorium within the City of Mound on the receipt, processing, or approval of land use and subdivision requests that propose the construction of multi-family housing in the City. For purposes of the moratorium, "multi-family housing" includes rowhouse dwellings, townhome dwellings, apartment multiple-family dwellings, or mixed-use apartments dwellings. It does not include developments or redevelopments of 10 or fewer residential units.
