

## Garage Sale and Special Event Signs

### City Code Section 119

Garage sale signs will be permitted in conjunction with the sale of household goods and materials from the private residences. Such signs shall be exempt from permits and fees but shall be subject to the following:

- Signs shall not exceed four square feet in area.
- The name and telephone number of the party responsible for the sale shall be clearly marked on the sign.
- Directional off-premises garage sale signs can be placed on private property providing that the property owners consent is obtained prior to the placement of such signs.
- The use of garage sale signs shall be limited to five occasions per calendar year, per residence.
- Boutiques, craft sales, and other sales events of handcrafted merchandise shall be subject to all garage sale signage provisions.
- Garage sale signs shall be limited to five days per occurrence.
- Garage sale signs placed in the right-of-way shall be placed a minimum of five feet from the street pavement or curb and shall not obstruct visibility at intersections.
- Signs may not be on the right-of-way of county and state roads.
- Garage sale signs shall be removed immediately following the sale.

Special event signs shall be permitted subject to the regulations as set forth above.

The improper placement of signs may result in their removal by the Community Service Officer.
