APRIL 23, 2019**

1. Open meeting

Mayor Salazar called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Fire Chief Greg Peterson presenting an Emergency Management training for public officials

Fire Chief Greg Peterson introduced the incident command team, played a brief video explaining national and local emergency management efforts since 9/11, and then conducted an abbreviated training based on a fictional tornado emergency in Mound. Peterson said the Mayor is required to declare an emergency in order for the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) to be implemented and the role of the City Council is primarily to authorize expenditures according to the City of Mound Procurement Policy and to be informed in order to be available to the public and have a basis to reassure the public that the emergency is under control.
